



Amendment of the ACG Charter

The 15th ACG General Meeting November 4, 2011 – Seoul, Korea

Background



- Quorum for Executive Committee physical meeting:
- According to the current ACG Charter, the Executive Committee physical meeting requires more than two-thirds (2/3) of Executive Committee Members to attend.
- For more flexible and swift activities, the Executive Committee had a discussion in this issue at the CSD11 Conference in Cape Town, South Africa. At the meeting,
 - The Executive Committee Chairman took a vote on three options:
 (i) round down to 2/3
 (ii) fixed at 4 members
 (iii) majority
 - Among these three options, (iii) majority was adopted by a 6 to 1 vote.
 - The Executive Committee agreed to amend the ACG Charter at the 15th ACG Annual General Meeting (ACG15).

Amended provision



• Old provision

5.3.2.2 Quorum

The quorum for physical Executive Committee Meetings shall be satisfied when <u>more than two-thirds (2/3)</u> of Executive Committee Members have attended and the rest of the Executive Committee Members have submitted their valid votes under the name of their representatives or secondary representatives.

New provision

5.3.2.2 Quorum

The quorum for physical Executive Committee Meetings shall be satisfied when <u>more than one-half (1/2)</u> of Executive Committee Members have attended and the rest of the Executive Committee Members have submitted their valid votes under the name of their representatives or secondary representatives.
