CHARTER AMENDMENT on Changes to the Cross Training Seminar (CTS) Host Application Period

CTS Preparations Timeframe



- Short timeframe for CTS preparations
 - CTS host has only about 6 months to prepare
 - Coordinator also expressed concerns for creating richer programs due to time constraints
- Limited time to prepare for logistics, contents, and invitations for guests and speakers

Action	Annual General Meeting (AGM)	CTS
Host Application Period	April 1~30	October 1~31
Host Announcement	May	November
Actual Event	September ~ December	April ~ June
Preparation Time	16~19 months	6~8 months

CTS Host Application Period Amendment



- > Extend preparation time by changing the host application period
 - Actual event timeframe of CTS (Spring) seems appropriate considering the AGM (Fall-Winter) hosting season, thus change application period
- Proposal for CTS Host Application Period Amendment
 - One month after the General Meeting Host Application Period
 - Call for the host: by April 30 of one year in advance
 - Application for the host: period of May 1 to May 31
 - Applicant has about a year of preparation time (effective for 2019 host and onwards)
