## 2. Opening and introduction of the General Meeting Session

The General Meeting Session opened and was presided over by President and CEO of Central Securities Depository of Iran (CSDI,) Dr. Mohammadreza Mohseni, who served as the host of the 20th ACG General Meeting. Twenty-one member institutions were present, establishing the quorum for the General Meeting.

## 2. Confirmation of minutes of ACG-20 General Meeting

Taiwan Depository & Clearing Corporation, Ms. Wen Yen, read out the minutes of the 19<sup>th</sup> ACG General Meeting held in Taiwan on November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and thanked all the delegates for their participation and support.

## 3. ACG Executive Committee Activity Report

On behalf of the ACG Secretariat, Senior Officer of Marketing and Product Development at CDCPL, Mr. Faizan Shujaat, briefed the audience on the recent activities of the ACG Executive Committee, which included:

#### Membership Fees

 During the 19th ACG General Meeting in Taiwan it was decided through voting to introduce Membership Fees to the ACG members. In the conference call, all EC members supported the idea of flat fee structure with equal right and a nominal fee like 1000 USD per year for all ACG members. However, it was also highlighted that before membership fees can be implemented, the administrative issues for collection and recovery of fees need to be addressed.

Membership Fees will be used to meet certain expenses. These expenses can include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Website Maintenance
- ➤ Contributions to WFC (Single Disclosure, E-Learning etc.)
- > Training workshops (like for CPSS-IOSCO)
- Any other expenses that may arise from time to time (WFC meetings, Trainers etc.)

## • Associate Membership:

The primary purpose behind this endeavor is to enrich the association by adding greater depth in the membership structure and increase the intellectual and experiential diversity as well as creating a funding avenue for various ACG activities.







- ➤ The membership applications will be reviewed by the Executive Committee on a case to case basis with a fee like 2000 USD per year.
- The additional clause in the ACG Charter with respect to associate membership has been included with concurrence from the Executive Committee. It was highlighted that fund managed could be similar to the criteria adopted for collecting funds for Single Disclosure Project where an ACG member, country with relax tax implications and foreign remittance can be selected for managing and administering ACG funds.

## • Enhancing Members' Participation

ACG Secretariat taking initiatives to enhance participation:

- ➤ Members were encouraged to participate in various WFC Task Forces.
- Emphasized on participation in surveys and conference calls where appropriate.
- Encouraging members for volunteering to host various ACG events such as Cross Training Seminars.
- The participation of ACG members in the General Meeting has increased in comparison to previous years.
- Cross-Training Seminar in Vietnam was attended by approximately 100 participants including several representatives from non-member institutions such as Thomas Murray, SWIFT and also few representatives from Algeria Clearing.
- The current ACG Secretariat during its complete tenure has ensured 100% participation from ACG members in the Depository Information Gathering Project (DIGP) by identifying and facilitating the members who were unable to participate in the past.

#### ACG Newsletter

Mr. Faizan Shujaat said last year, the Secretariat proposed to launch the ACG e-Newsletter on a bi-annual basis. The first edition of the ACG e-Newsletter was circulated among the CSD industry in December 2015 and the subsequent edition in July 2016.

As a result of this initiative, the Secretariat would be able to keep ACG members updated on the latest events and developments in the Asia-Pacific region and elsewhere. This also acts as a motivating factor for the members to participate by sharing their recent activities.

The next edition of ACG Newsletter will be circulated during the course of January 2017.







- Around 100 participants including representatives from non-member institutions such as the Thomas Murray and SWIFT attended the 18<sup>th</sup> Cross Training seminar hosted by the Vietnam Securities Depository (VSD.)
- ACG is collaborating with various organizations to enhance the prominence and presence of the organization globally.

One of these organizations is NeMa which was organized by Informa. It has been collaborating with ACG for the past two years and now ACG partners in NeMa Asia, NeMa Europe and Global Custody Forum. As a result of this partnership, ACG members get exclusive benefits such as Panel/Moderating slot, discount, etc. Informa has also partnered with other regional associations for similar regional events as well as other events of such nature.

- Another initiative that has been taken into consideration is the introduction of ACG Fact book. The information will be collected from ACG members on a voluntary basis and will include comparable factsheets with basic facts and figures of CSDs across the Asia Pacific Region.
- During WFC Board meeting in September 2015, Chairman of the WFC Board stressed the need of WFC CSD Fact Book which can be released in WFC, 2017. NSDL India attended the meeting in the capacity of observers and volunteered to lead this initiative on behalf of ACG. Currently, the fact books of four regional associations namely ECSDA, AECSD, ACSDA and AMEDA have been published and are readily available apart from ACG which needs to be developed first and then the data of all five associations can be compiled.

#### 4. Report on Senior Management Meeting

The report of the Senior Management Meeting held on Wednesday December 7, 2016, with 30 senior ACG executives members in attendance was delivered by Mr. Shariq Naseem, Head of Product Development & Marketing of CDC Pakistan on behalf of ACG Secretariat and is as follows:-

#### • Membership Fee

ACG Secretariat and Executive committee supported the idea of a Flat Fee Structure with equal rights and nominal fee like \$1000 per year for all ACG members. However, there are certain issues that need to be addressed before implementing the membership fee like fund administration and changes in the ACG charter.

### • Associate Membership

The ACG Secretariat and the Executive Committee decided that Executive Committee would evaluate each associate membership application on a case to case basis. Furthermore, an ACG member with more lenient relax tax implication and foreign







remittance could be requested to manage ACG funds.

#### • Update on WFC 2017

On behalf of the ACG Secretariat, Mr. Shariq Naseem gave updates on the WFC 2017. The WFC 2017 conference is scheduled during November 14-17, 2017, in Hong Kong, and will be hosted by CDC Pakistan, CSDC China, HKEX Hong Kong and NSDL India on behalf of ACG. All ACG members were updated on the themes, schedule and activities planned for the conference and were requested to participate and support since the conference is hosted by ACG after a decade.

#### 5. Amendment of ACG Charter

In light of the introduction and implementation of Associate Membership, Mr. Shariq Naseem, Head of Product Development & Marketing (CDCPL) proposed the following amendments in the ACG Charter.

## 3b Associate Membership:

## 3.1b Eligibility

Associate Members can be any of the following target groups as approved by General Meeting.

- a. Industry participants such as Custodian Banks, Stock Exchanges
- b. CSDs and clearing houses outside the Asia-Pacific region

#### 3.2b Rights

Associate Members shall have the following rights:

- a. To attend Annual General Meetings prescribed in Article 4.2 (hereinafter referred to as "Annual General Meetings")
- b. To attend Cross Training Seminar prescribed in Article 7 (hereinafter referred to as "Seminar")
- c. Are free to be a part of any Task Force / Working Group but cannot hold the position of convener.
- d. Associate members are only entitled to the rights stated in Article 3b of the ACG charter.

The proposed clauses with respect to Associate Membership were approved by all ACG members present in the meeting.

## 6. Dissolution and Re-establishment of Task Forces

The General Meeting Chairman informed that the five existing Task Forces i.e. Exchange of Information Task Force, Legal Task Force, New Business Initiative Task Force, Risk and Recovery Management Task Force and Technical Task Force were dissolved in the







General Meeting.

General Meeting Chairman informed the meeting that JASDEC, CSDC, KSD, CDCPL and NSDL are willing to continue their Task Force activities as convener for next 3 years.

#### 7. Selection of Next Task Force Conveners

In backdrop of the approval of the General Meeting the General Meeting Chairman announced the Task Forces and their conveners as follows:-

- Exchange of Information Task Force, Convener: Japan Securities Depository Center, Inc. (JASDEC)
- Legal Task Force, Convener: China Securities Depository & Clearing Corporation Limited (CSDC)
- New Business Initiative Task Force, Convener: Korea Securities Depository (KSD)
- Technical Task Force, Convener: National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL)
- Risk and Recovery Management Task Force, Convener: Central Depository Company of Pakistan Limited (CDCPL)

#### 8. Selection of Executive Committee Members

Following the General Meeting, elections for the three elected Executive Committee seats was held. Among the four candidates, Central Security Depository of Iran (CSDI,) Taiwan Depository and Clearing Corporation (TDCC) and Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL) from India were elected for the next three years.

#### 9. Appointment and Endorsement of Executive Committee Chairman

On the sidelines of the General Meeting, the newly formed Executive Committee convened a short meeting in Espinas Palace hotel to select the next Chairman of the Committee.

Thereafter, the General Meeting Chairman announced that Chief Executive Officer of CDCPL, Mr. Muhammad Hanif, was re-elected as the ACG Executive Committee Chairman and CDCPL will continue as the ACG Secretariat for next 3 years.

# 10. Announcement of the 19th ACG Cross Training Seminar Host

Vice President, National Securities Depository Limited, Mr. Samar Banwat, further delivered a speech together with a video presentation as the host of the 19<sup>th</sup> Cross-Training Seminar.

# 11. Invitation to 21st ACG General Meeting

Managing Director of Hong Kong Exchange and Clearing Limited, Mr. Hon Cheung Poon, made a video presentation about Hong-Kong and invited all ACG members to Hong-Kong for the 21th ACG General Meeting which is being merged with WFC Conference in November 2017.







# 12. Closing Remarks by ACG20 General Meeting Chairman

President and CEO of Central Depository IRAN (CSDI,) Dr. Mohammadreza Mohseni, then appreciated all ACG members for their participation in ACG-20 and expressed hope that the ACG members will strengthen their mutual relations in the years to come.
