- A survey was circulated among the ACG member CSDs, designed to examine their scope of business continuity planning.



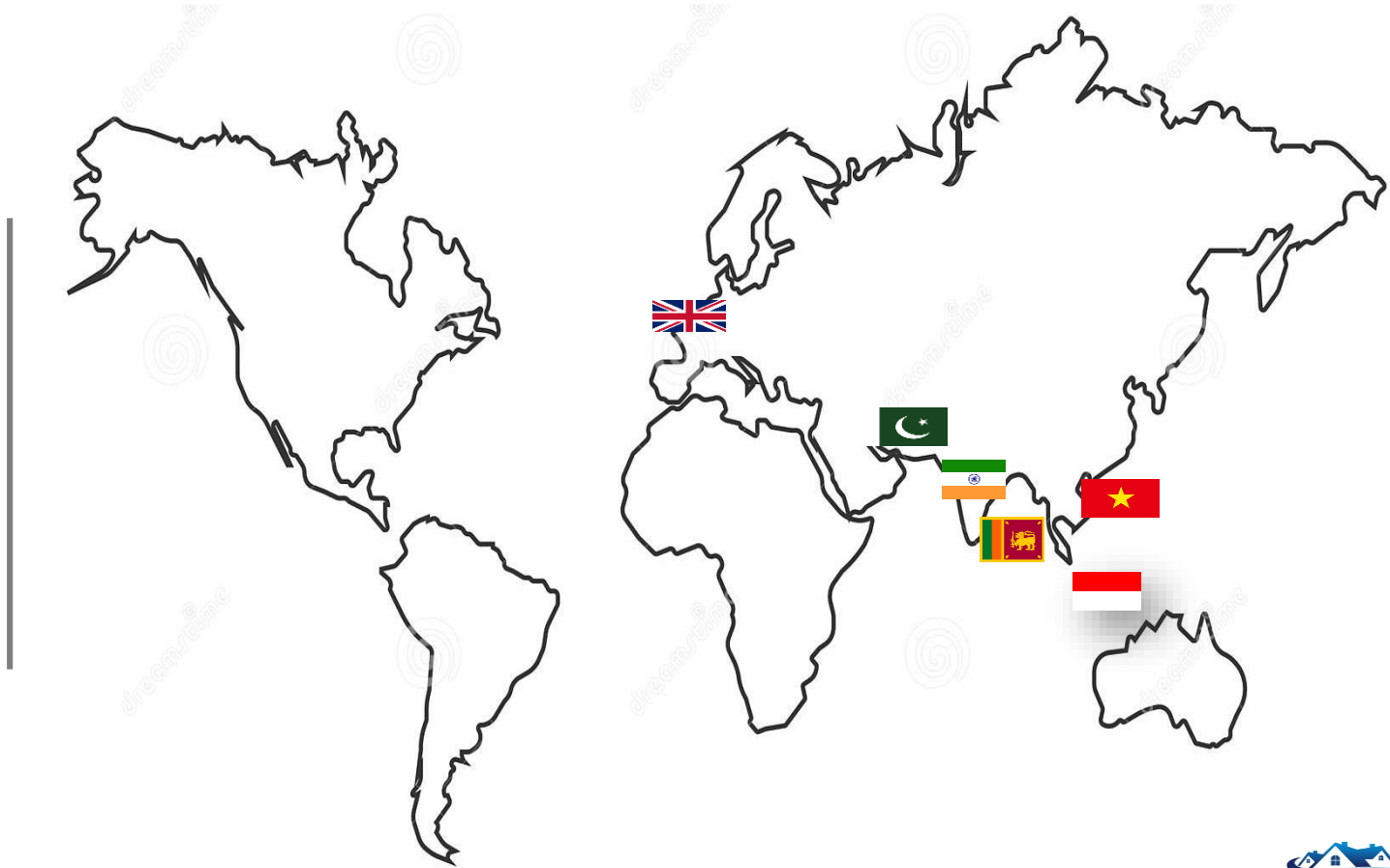
